The installation of the temporary fence is approved for the duration of the presence of the gas tanks at their current location, notwithstanding that the tanks themselves are in violation of the Historic District bylaw. The three 4'x6' cedar lattice panels should each be framed on four sides with 1x4 trim boards, so as to cover each seam, supported by four 4x4 PT or cedar posts, and painted green.
