

In the records of the Town of Royalston kept on file in the Town Clerks office, I have made a chronology of the Actions taken at Town Meetings in regards to the discontinuation of roads .

Annual Town Meeting March 10, 1967

Article 18. The Town voted to abandon a portion of the Winchendon Road from the intersection of Brown Road west 1,842 Ft. to driveway of the Matson property.

Annual Town Meeting May 11, 1979

Article 23. The town voted to discontinue the following roads;
Stockwell road from the Town dump to Millyard road (alst known as Town Dump Rd.)
Toney Road starting 1,000 Ft. from Neale Place.
Greenhall Road beginning 1,900 Ft. from Neale Road
Wiley Road
Pike Road beginning 1,300 Ft. from N.E. Fitzwilliam Road
Dyer Road
Metcalf Road (with the following objection filed by Paul Posnak, Concert Pianist, College Professor, his lawyer could not be here asked to voice an objection to be recorded by the Town Clerk in case of needed appeal. If road is discontinued would create Land Lock, road should be kept open for " Common convenience and necessity " wording from General Laws Chapter 82 Line 4.

Annual Town Meeting May 11, 1984

Article 30. To see if the Town will vote to discontinue all or portions of Adams road, Loomis Road, Greenhall Road, Deland Road, Falls Road or take any action thereon.

Action Taken. Voted to pass over request to discontinue above roads.

Annual Town Meeting May 9, 1986

Article 9. To see if the Town will vote to reconsider the following Article 23, of the Annual Town Meeting of May 11, 1979.

To see if the Town will vote to discontinue the following Town Roads or take any action there on.

Stockwell Road from the Town Dump to Millyard Road (also know as Town Dump Road)
Toney Road
Greenhall Road
Wiley Road
Pike Road from Lawrence Brook West to N. Fitzwilliam Road
Dyer Road
Metcalf Road

Action Taken Town Voted to Table this Article.

Annual Town Meeting May 11, 1990

Article 6. To see if the Town will Vote to discontinue Adams Road

Action taken Voted not to discontinue Adams Road.

Article 7. To see if the Town will vote to discontinue Loomis Road from Prospect Hill to North Fitzwilliam Road.

Action Taken Voted not to discontinue Loomis Road.

Article 8. To see if the Town will vote to discontinue Sinivouri Road.

Action taken Voted not to discontinue Sinivouri Road.

Article 9. To see if the Town will vote to discontinue Tully Road.

Action Taken Voted not to discontinue any portion of Tully Road.

Article 10. To see if the Town will vote to discontinue Turnpike Road 1.34 miles, beginning at Deland Road and ending at the N.H. State Line.

Action taken Voted not to discontinue Turnpike Road.

Article 12. To see if the Town will vote to discontinue Stockwell Road beginning at Mill yard Road.

Action taken Voted not to discontinue Stockwell Road.

Article 13. To see if the Town will vote to discontinue Frye Hill Road beginning at North Fitzwilliam road.

Action Taken Voted not to discontinue any portion of Frye Hill Road.

Article 14. To see if the Town will vote to discontinue Deland Road beginning at the Winchendon Town line to Priest Brook.

Action taken Voted not to discontinue Deland Road.

Special Town Meeting August 16, 1990

Article 1. To see if the Town will vote to discontinue a portion of Deland road from the Winchendon Town line west to Priest Brook .7 miles.

Action Taken Voted to Table this Article.

Special Town Meeting October 8, 1990

Article 3. To see if the Town will reopen that portion of Stockwell road (Old Town Dump Road) that was discontinued .

Action Taken Voted not to reopen.

These are all the records on Discontinuation of Roads found to date.
