- ALL TOWN BUILDINGS ARE CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC
- ALL TOWN SPONSORED EVENTS ARE CANCELED
- SENIOR LUNCHEES ARE CANCELLED
- ALL ESSENTIAL SERVICES, INCLUDING DPW, POLICE AND FIRE WILL CONTINUE
- TRANSFER STATION HOURS REMAIN THE SAME: SAT 7AM-1:45PM
- POST OFFICE HOURS REMAIN THE SAME - ONE PERSON AT A TIME AT THE WINDOW PLEASE

WHAT **YOU** DO MAKES A DIFFERENCE

DO YOUR PART TO SLOW THE SPREAD

- **IF YOU ARE SICK** stay home and contact your doctor. If you do not have a doctor, contact an urgent care facility before you go.
- **IF YOU ARE WELL** stay in touch with neighbors who may need assistance
- **AVOID CROWDS** and work from home if possible
- **PRACTICE GOOD HYGIENE**
 - Wash your hands and keep them away from your face
 - Cover coughs and sneezes
 - Disinfect surfaces frequently
- **PRACTICE RESPONSIBLE SOCIAL DISTANCING**
