Move and reset stone pillars **from** left front corner of barn past maple tree to small garage, Reset 90 degrees from maple tree aligned along left side of driveway.

Linking heavy black chain from the corner of the barn left to column at the tree, then 90 degrees from post to post across driveway entrance.

These are all existing stones that were previously; partially buried, had fallen over or were misaligned. The tree has grown around one of these posts.

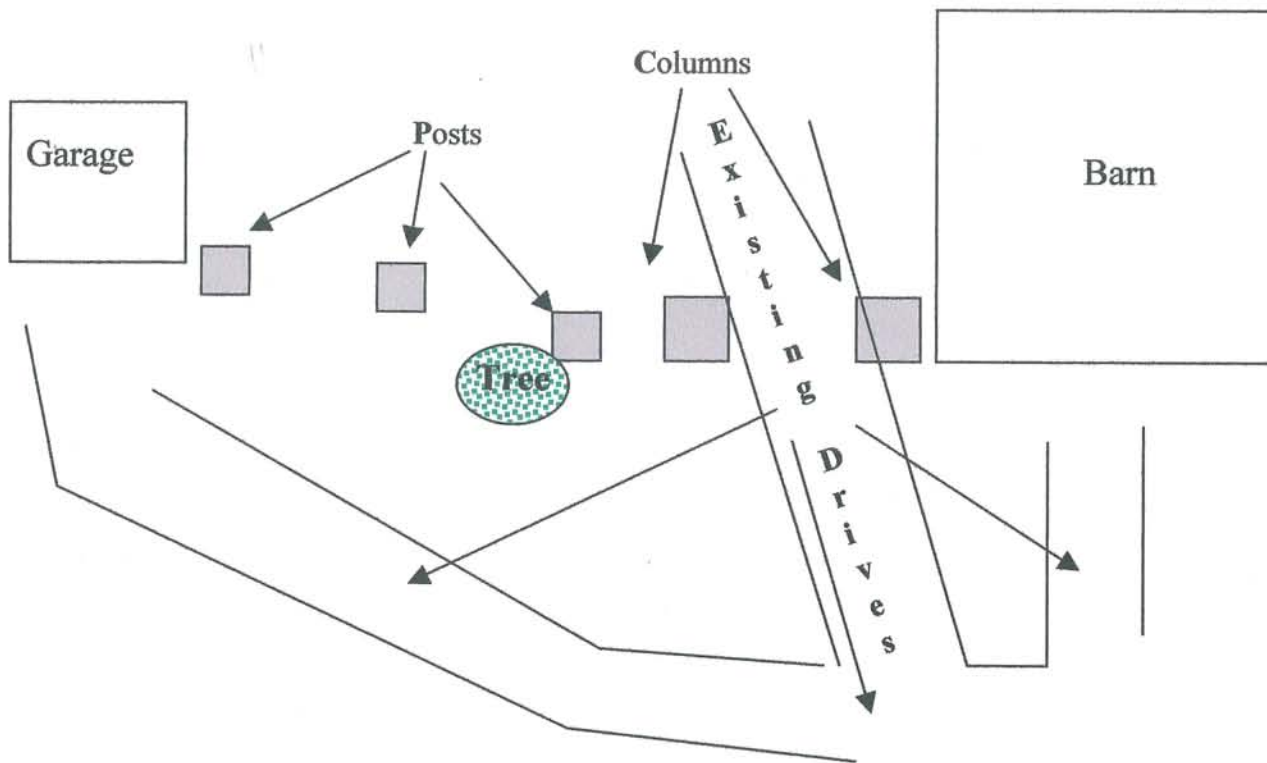

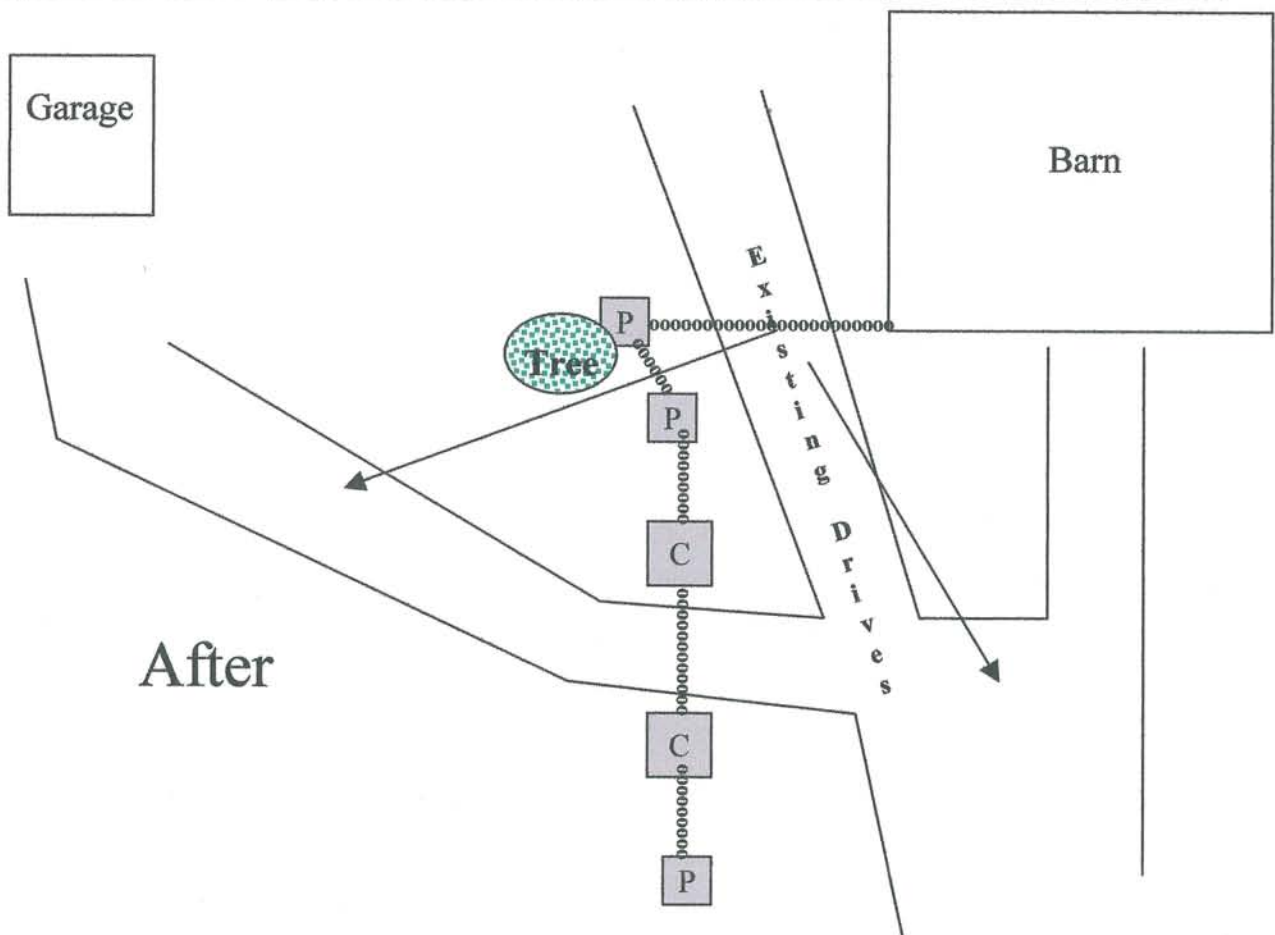

The granite posts are pre-existing on the property and have been reset and realigned within fifteen feet of their original positions. These pictures show two of the posts. One actually wrapped by the tree. Many properties throughout New England are known to have pillars linked with heavy chain, ie. Fitzwilliam Common, Swanzey, New London NH, etc. etc.
