

We request approval for the following changes to the back of our house. (FYI: The back of our house can only be viewed from a public way from the common during the winter and is approximately 500 feet away)
Item 1 – Replacement of existing double hung window with similar vinyl replacement window in pantry area on back of ell as noted in diagram. White 9/9 grills installed.
Item 2 – Installation of (4) 30" x 77" doors (double sliders) with white wood grills. Painted white and trimmed with 5/4 6" boards. 2" x 10" P.T. Deck nailer board installed 8" below door. (Note: Request for construction of porch/deck to be submitted at a later date)
Item 3 – Installation of (2) 36" x 77" doors (hinged) with white wood grills. Painted white and trimmed same as above.
Item 4 – Installation of a 48" x 48" Casement window with white wood grills.
Item 5 – Installation of two sets of carriage lights. 17 1/2" high by 6 1/2" wide black carriage lights. One on each side of the 4 slider doors and one on each side of the double doors.
Both sets of lights will be located 6 feet in elevation from threshold of doorway and be 3" from the trim boards. Lanterns are electric, black, and will utilize a 40 watt bulb. Appropriate 6" x 9" wood plates will be installed to hold all lights. Aluminum flashing is installed on the top of each plate. A 1/4 round bead will be routered into the bottom of each plate. Plates will be painted with approved yellow to match house. Signature


