The spotlight that illuminates the Town Hall was recently changed by the electric company when they were asked to repair the light. The electric company claims that they no longer install the white Mercury Vapor lights because of environmental restrictions on Mercury. They also state that no white lights are approved by their engineering department. So, the only alternative is the high pressure sodium fixture which emits an orange hue.

The Selectboard is applying for approval of the new fixture with the new sodium bulb. The fixture is similar in size to the old approximately 12"x12"x12" and mounted in the same position on a pole near the Town Hall. The enclosure is white metal with a glass lens.
