Detailed Description

The dimensions of the grape arbor are $9\text{ft.} \times 9\text{ft.} \times 7'$ 11" high. Four 7 ft. columns in the same style as columns existing on the screened porches of the house support the traditional trellis above. The "roof" trellis sits 11" above the columns so that the total height of the structure is 7' 11".

The columns are primed & painted white to match the existing columns on the house porches. The trellis above is stained in a natural wood color to carry the grape vine and so as not to compete with the columns.

The position of the arbor on our side of the library garden fence is to provide a traditional structure for the existing very well established grape vine on our property that has been strangling the surrounding trees & bushes.
