## **Detailed description**

We would like to enlarge by 16'' toward the South the 54 " H x 34" W door opening to the storage area under the South deck at 4 on the Common. The deck was built in the 1950's and it is supported by cinder block walls. The opening is in the East wall, which is not bearing. It is visible from the South Royalston road, about 500 feet away.

The width of the existing door will be reduced to about 25" and a matching 25" wide door will be installed. The new trim will follow the existing design. Everything will be painted white, as it is today.

See the picture below, looking toward the West. The vertical tape measure indicates the future South side of the opening.
