A Greek-temple garden folly based on the one at Prince Charles' Highgrove House.


The 10x12 central "temple" is flanked on each side by open pergolas.

Construction is all wood set upon a deck.


Just 8" above grade. It will be unfinised and left to weather to gray.

There are no curved lines in the structure.




Brien McCerthy's interpretation of the Highgrove Horse folly.
