## **Detailed description**



The bulkhead was built with poured concrete and blocks in the 1950's. The current cover is made of tongue and grove boards, in very bad condition and leaking. Modern tongue and groove boards are not expected to last. We propose to use T1-11 exterior plywood with simulated 8" boards, replicating the design used at 4 South Royalston Rd. It will be painted white (as was the existing one) or green (will not show dirt).
