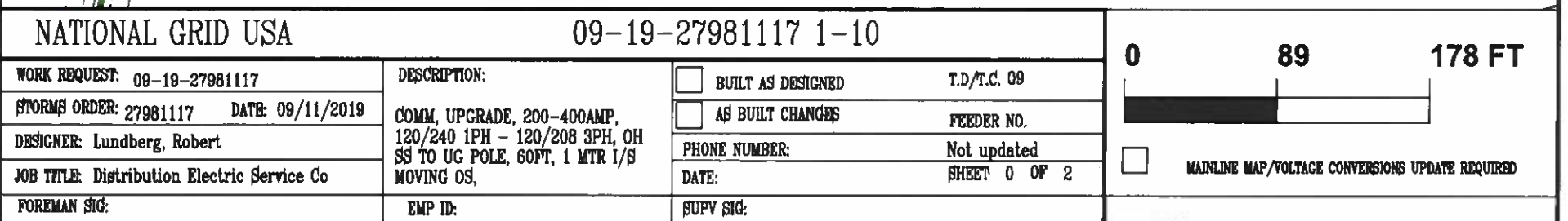
I understand that today is a busy day and that restoring service is rightly the first priority.

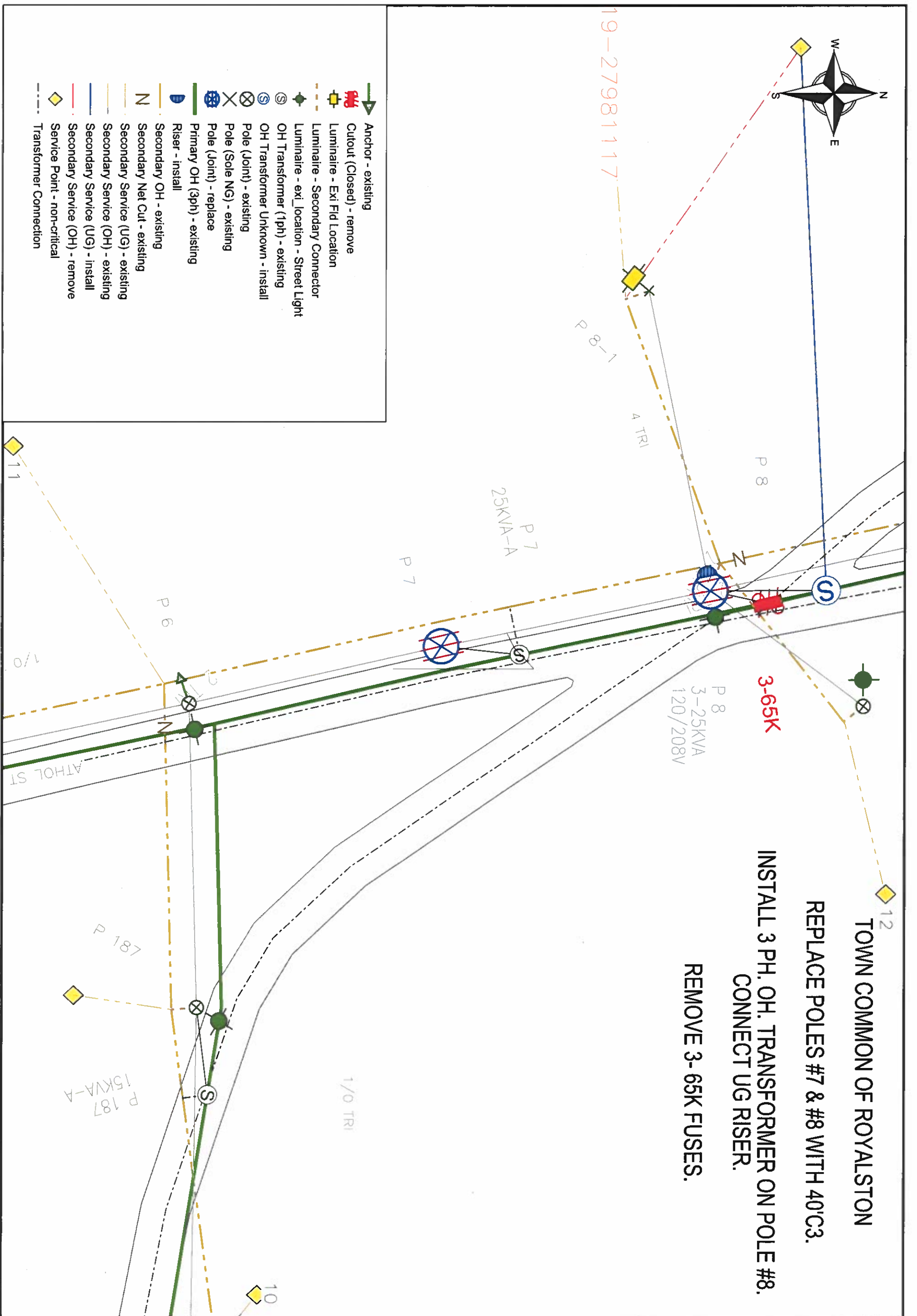
What you sent me still leaves some open questions:

- It looks like poles 7, 8 and 10 (but not 9) will be replaced. Not clear if pole 8-1 will be removed. *Pole 8-1 will not be removed. The service line running to it will be removed however.*
- What is the above ground height of a 40'C3 pole? *About 34'*
- What will happen to the light fixture currently on pole 8? *If National Grid owned, it will be transferred over. If town owned, the town will likely have to transfer it.*
