I understand that today is a busy day and that restoring service is rightly the first priority.

What you sent me still leaves some open questions:

- It looks like poles 7, 8 and 10 (but not 9) will be replaced. Not clear if pole 8-1 will be removed. *Pole 8-1 will not be removed. The service line running to it will be removed however.*
- What is the above ground height of a 40'C3 pole? About 34'
- What will happen to the light fixture currently on pole 8? If National Grid owned, it will be transferred over. If town owned, the town will likely have to transfer it.
