This is a safety issue, to prevent children from running into the driveway and being hit by a car. The fence is temporary in nature, and can be removed easily. We intend to remove it when we leave the Raymond School building. The fence is not visible at all. It can only be seen from about 10 feet away. One pressure treated post was installed in the corner near the handicap ramp, and the rest of the fence is attached to small posts pounded into the ground. The mesh is approximately 2" by 3" mesh.
