Selectmen submitted an application to change the light on the town hall from the former to the currently replace high-pressure sodium (which emits an orange hue). The electric company changed the light when asked by the selectmen to replace the bulb. The Commission accepted the application for consideration and a public hearing was scheduled for July 21, 2005 at 7:15 pm in the Town Hall.

Selectmen submitted an application to add a sign to the Town Hall announcing the building. The Commission thought that a different design, perhaps "Royalston Town Hall" banner style over the door and "Selectmen's Office" and hours next to the door. Andy West withdrew the application for Selectman to be resubmitted.

The Commission received an application from the Congregational Church to reface the spire of the steeple with an interlocking metal shingle. The clapboard face is about 3". The steel interlocking design will expand and contract better than the failing fiberglass in place now. The shingle is by Berridge Manufacturing trade name Hylar 5000 and will be Bone White. Bob Casingino made a motion to accept the application for consideration and hold a public hearing on July 21, 7:00 pm in the Town Hall, Roger seconded. Motion carried with John Divoll abstaining.

Old Business

Peter reported to Andy that a company in Lynn makes the historic signs in Montague, MA. The company makes many of the interstate highway signs. Andy will contact Keith Newton at the Highway department and ask how much a sign would cost.

Bob reported that there is a new curve sign erected near the library. Andy will research the reason that it was put up.
