Meeting Minutes

Date: June 16, 1994

Meeting called to order at 8:10 PM

John McClure moved to suspend the reading of the minutes and old business until later in the meeting.

New Business

George Krasowski submitted an application to build a wood fence on his previously approved patio. After brief discussion, Andy moved to approve the application. Patience seconded. The application was approved unanimously, with George abstaining, as 3-94.

Old Business

The minutes from the May 19, 1994 meeting were read and accepted.

John McClure gave the commission an update on the Smith's returned application. He said that they will not permanently remove the two porches on the house. They may ask for approval to expand the side porch.

John McClure also said that he went to the last Select Committee meeting to ask the Mass Electric representative, who was there requesting permits, to look into the District's ~~missing~~ light fixtures. The representative said that he would.

The Selectmen are working on resolving the conflict-of-interest issue. John McClure took the personal information of the Historic District Commission members to the committee at their last meeting.

John McClure purchased seven 14-foot trees with money from the tree replacement fund. The total cost was \$262.50. McClure purchased 4 Sugar Maples and 3 Red Maples to be planted this fall. He said some of them will be planted near the fire station and near Swindel's house. The remainder of the tree fund will be used to plant and mulch the trees.
