## Meeting Minutes

Date: July 21, 1994

Attendees: John McClure, Peter Kraniak, John Poor, George Krasowski, Patience Bundschuh, Rick Carrier, and Alternate Andy West (not voting).

Meeting called to order at 8:45 PM

The minutes from the meeting of June 16, 1994 were not available.

### Old Business

John McClure said that he found some acceptable photo albums to store the Commission's photographs in. They will be purchased from WalMart.

John McClure has been trying to interview Catherine Cole and Peggy Langlois about town history. He will continue his efforts.

As of this date no light standards have been replaced by Mass. Electric.

John Poor told the commission that he saw mention in the newspaper of the selectmen efforts to resolve the conflict-of-interest issue.

### New Business

Alan Bowers submitted an application to replace the roofing material on the front of Lillis Bower's house. The application requested that the color of the ~~front~~ <sup>back</sup> roof be changed to match the ~~back~~ <sup>front</sup> roof as the two sides are 2 different colors. Some Commission members had reservations about approving the application without an exact color specified on the application. Peter Kraniak telephoned Alan from the meeting to question him about the exact color of the shingles. Bowers said the color was "Silvery White." Andy West proposed that the application be accepted with the condition that the application be amendment to include the color "Silvery White" and then initialed by Alan Bowers. John Poor spoke against approving incomplete applications. George Krasowski seconded the motion. All members voted in favor except John Poor who opposed. The application was approved as 4-94.



The application was unanimously approved as 5-94.
