HDC requests that the Bundschuhs submit an application for said arbor for consideration at the next meeting on Oct 21. Motion seconded. Approved unanimously

CPC: Celt sought advisory from committee regarding jurisdiction overl cemeteries. After consulting district map it appears only the "Old Centerl Cemetery" falls within the HDC purview.
