The meeting began with minutes and Old Business

The minutes of the July meeting were read and a motion to accept them ~~is~~ was made by Andy West 2nd by Rick Carrier - all approved. July's minutes were accepted.

The minutes of the August meeting were read and a motion was made by Andy West to accept them Rick Carrier 2nd they were approved and accepted.

During and after the reading of the August minutes there was a discussion of the

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secretaries role and whether it's ~~was~~ appropriate for a member to be filling ~~it~~ ~~the~~. Karen Pickford expressed that it was difficult to simultaneously record a meeting and participate fully in it. There was discussion about the possibility of an independent person filling the secretarial role - perhaps in even a paid position.

- Patience B said she had called Diane Richardson who is a volunteer secretary for the planning board - she was not interested
- Clarence R. suggested an appointed secretary ~~that is~~ ^{that would be} a non-voting member
 - Andy West noted that ~~would require~~ the world require the Selectmen approval whereas if we were to hire someone - we could do it under our own discretion -
- Patience suggested an intern - and other ideas were discussed ^{immediately}
 - there was no ~~solution~~ determined - Karen Pickford stated she would try to be more vigilant w/ not taking and Henry Feldt said he would not places on the tape that certain discussion

This would help immediately - for a long term solution the Selectmen would be notified that we need a secretary and perhaps an independent person ~~can~~ be found.

This discussion led to the Budget - it is now \$50 per year - ^{and} goes back into the town fund if it is not used.

Patience Bush noted that this budget is inadequate - already ~~\$33~~ and K. P. had spent more out of pocket ^{each} to put together the H.D.C. Books. Linda Alger told P.B. that ^{possibly} these expenses could be reimbursed by submitting a ^{regular} ~~regular~~ and receipts at the Selectman's ^{the} Special Town Meeting in Jan

Patience then noted that after the Town Meeting in May ^{The H.D.C. should} request a larger budget - ~~it~~ needs to come up with a realistic budget that includes the printing of ^{H.D.C.} books - the newsletter, and a possible hiring of secretary. (As a ^{reference point} the newsletter alone was 84⁰⁰ to print - and ^{The Commission} hopes to do this 4 times a year -

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- prices of these things can be played around with but any way around it ^{The HDC} we need a larger budget and a well thought out request for it.

For now ^{the commission} needs to make sure all ~~of~~ materials are available at the library - since ~~it~~ cannot afford mailings and lg printings.

OLD BUSINESS

at this point previous chairman Andy West took over to ~~cover~~ wrap up items from ~~the~~ previous ^{meeting his last} as chairman.

A vote was taken - and unanimously approved - certificate of appropriateness issued # 8-99.

- ② Marjorie Chases application for an after the fact gate at her property on Tye Hill Rd. At the previous meeting member John Divoll had informed the commission of the "Right to Farm Law". Since that meeting which would supersede any bylaws or bylaws and renders this application moot. John Divoll ~~had~~ reported on his ~~information~~ commercial with the Farm Bureau - he received from them a copy of the Law which he read to the commission. A discussion followed about this - John Divoll ~~is~~ was very helpful and informative in explaining how this law applies to Marjorie Chases property - and how her property qualifies as a "farm".

- Andy West questions if the wording of the law ~~only allows~~ and its use of ~~the~~ term zoning ordinances and bylaws would rule this out.
- C. Rabideau suggests we should not act on this until we hear a response from the MHDLC.
- Karen Pickford suggests that we ask Marjorie Chase to change her

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application to one of non-applicability - so that the gate goes on record and we do not supersede farm law.

Patience reminds the commission that we have accepted the application and we must act ^{within} 60 days.

it is decided that we must take action and Andy West notes that we can grant a certificate of non-applic. to an application for appropriateness. He makes a motion to do this w/ reference to the right to farm law. Clarence Rab. 2nds the motion. The application is granted as certificate of non applicability with a unanimous vote. certificate # 9-99.

Andy West notes that although we have addressed this particular application we are still awaiting a response from the MHC about the Right to Farm Law.
