Massachusetts POST (Peace Officer Standards and Training) Commission

- The Mission is to improve policing and enhance public confidence in Law Enforcement by implementing a fair process for mandatory certification, discipline, and training for all peace officers in the Commonwealth
- Enhanced training and Re-training within three years
- Closure of the Part Time Police Academy

Royalston Residents Requirements

Part Time Force - \$208,695 (-133,843 FY24) need \$74,852 No Staff benefits.

Continues the current operation status. Provides the following: Weekday patrols: 7am-3pm Monday thru Friday Weekend patrols: 11am – 7pm Saturday & Sunday Funds Emergency Response Callouts: 4pm – 7am (difficult to cover with limited parttime staff) Maintain 12 Part-time Officers Provides 6,330 Operational hours plus 480 hours for required training.

One Full Time Officer - \$198,451 (-133,843 FY24) need \$97,608 w/benefits*.

Provides the following:

Weekday (Mon – Fri) patrols: 7 am-3 pm fulltime officer

Weekday (Mon - Fri) evening patrols: 3pm - 7pm covered by parttime officers. (difficult to cover)

Weekend (Saturday-Sunday) patrols: 11am – 7pm Saturday & Sunday (parttime staff)

Funds Emergency Response Callouts: 7pm – 7am (difficult to cover with limited parttime staff)

Maintain 1-Fulltime and 8-Parttime Officers

Provides 6,005 Operational hours plus 400 hours for required training.

Two Full Time Officers - \$225,651 (-133,843 FY24) need \$157,808 w/benefits (x2)*.

Provides the following:

Weekday (Mon – Fri) patrols: 7 am-3 pm

Weekday (Mon – Fri) patrols: 3 pm – 11pm

Weekend (Saturday-Sunday) patrols: 11am – 7pm Saturday & Sunday (parttime staff)

Funds Emergency Callouts (parttime staff) : 11pm – 7am Weekdays (parttime staff)

7am – 11am Saturday & Sundays

7pm – 7am Saturday & Sundays

Maintain 2-Fulltime and 8-Part-time Officers

Provides 6,394 Operational hours plus 400 hours for required training.

*Benefit package based on \$33,000 per officer. This was actually the figure thrown out when I previously asked what the DPW workers benefit package is for the DPW workers that took it.
